



General Situation in the North on night of 30th/31st October.

The Yser Inundation is Effective.

The general situation in Flanders on the night of the 30th/31st October was disquieting. The British Expeditionary Force had been continuously fighting for ten days; it had suffered heavy losses; its reserves were enhausted; and no reinforcements from the homeland of any importance, either of men or guns, were on their way to the theatre of war. The one bright feature in the picture was the certainty of the fullest co-operation between French and British, which General Dubois had manifested his firm intention to ensure. In his evening telegram to the Secretary of State for War Sir John French said little more than that considerable reinforcements had reached the enemy, . and that ground had been lost which it was hoped to retake by a counter-attack. It was obvious that General Dubois, having given up his reserve to the British, could hardly be expected to accomplish anything decisive. General d'Urbal, in fact, directed him to secure his position by completing the defensive works already begun, by constructing others, and by pulling out troops from the front line to form a new reserve. Though the 32nd Division was now



two from father which I got yesterday. I will now try and give you a slight account of our doings during the last few days but as they have been so varied it will be rather difficult. As I think I told you in my last letter I went up to the trenches on the night of September 29th to take ever command of the remnants of No I Company. I started off from the transport field with the cookers at 5-30, in the rain. We had to go about 2 miles along the main read and then turned off to the left to get into LOOS. Just before we get into the village a Jack Johnson exploded about 15 yards from the leading wagen but none of us were hit. The Battalien were holding a disused German communication trench running straight out on the left of Loos, and the lines were roughly as follows:

(P.T.O. for Map.)

When I arrived at 7-30, No 4 with the remnants of No 1 had just come in from digging trench B. This they had been doing all day under heavy fire and they were very exhausted having had no food for 24 hours. We seen get them some food and settled down for the night.

As you see by the diagram the trench we were holding was the second line. The ground slopes down slightly from trench A and then up again to trench B. It was ever this ground that the attack was made on Menday, one Company having attacked the farm and wood.

Septomber 30th, Thursday.

Stood to arms at dawn. Did not sleep in the night as it was so wet and cold. My Company held the part marked black with several machine guns in it. The trench is very shallow in parts but we cannot dig down as it is full of dead, so our only hope is that they went shell us. The men are trying to seep heles for themselves underneath the wall of the trench. I went round and talked to them about the attack, they were in extraordinary good spirits and quite attack, they were in extraordinary good spirits and quite roady for another go.

During the morning I started reorganizing the Company, which was no easy job with only two Sergeants left. We also started to dig a trench behind a bit of the line, as there were about 15 dead Gormans lying there who badly needed burying as they were beginning to get high.

Thank goodness it is a nico sunny day and the men can dry their kit a bit, what there is is very much tern but as there is any amount lying about they can make theirs up a bit.

About 12 the C.O. came round and told me to take half of the Company to trench A and get in touch with our 2nd Battalien, which I did. The new trench was much deeper and Battalion, which I did. safor.

Nothing doing much in the morning but after lunch the Bosches began shelling a bit, but most of their attention was directed on the mine head at LOOS which I suppose they thought was an observation post.

About five of our aeroplanes came over and were heavily shelled but without success. I have soon no Taubos yet and I boliove they hardly over go up now.

We were to have been relieved at 7 p.m. by the Suffelks but they novor turned up till 12.

1st October. (Complete my first year's service).

Startod off 2 a.m. and marched back about 6 miles to a village about 3 miles S.W. of B. Got in at 6 absolutely dead beat. Slept till 3 in the afternoon, when I got up and had breakfast. They had just finished calling the roll and our casualties in No 1 as follows:

KILLED WOUNDED MISSING OFFICERS 7 N.C.O '3 & MEN 8 53 39 (3)

The officers wounded are Vivian and Ritchie but neither of thom bad. Poor Crabbo is missing but I am sure there is no doubt he was killed whilst getting over the wall of the farm, as I have asked these who were near him.

Fifty mon came up from the base this afternoon for No 1, so I have got quite a good Company now.

I am mossing with No 2 Company as they have only two officers left and I am by myself.

What a joy it is to have a bed again and not such a bad one either.

Octobor 2nd.

Paraded 9 and read out various things to the men, one thing especially worthy of repeating:-

"An English Officer who was in A ---- on the 25th roports that the Germans when they recaptured one of their trenches, collected all the British wounded, placed them between two traverses and there bombed them to douth."

I think this will help our fellows to know what to do when their revenge comes


I had to collect the names of those who had done well in the attack. The only means of finding out as all the officers are casualties was to ask the men. They were all unanimous about Ritchie, I believe he did splendidly. Several of the men were also specially mentioned.

How long we remain here I don't know, but don't think for long.

The enclosed are two buttons out off one of the aforementioned Boschos. I bolieve he was a Bavarian Give Ru one, I got a letter from him to-day. When you
write please thank him for it. Tell him I have not been
able to find one of the helmets he mentions, but will do
my bost next time I am up.

Our casualties in officers killed were extraordinarily light considering - only one - and six wounded, but I am afraid 1st Coldstreams and Scots took a bad knock. our 4th Battalion I hoar Miles Ponsonby diod of wounds; and Tommy Thorno killed.
